Repairs effected to No. 2. Dynamis engine in account of fuel oil treatment

Four Star boiler appears to have been renewed. Several jackets up. Compensation rings previously fitted in all boilers have been renewed. Several tubes dealt with & boiler tested satisfactorily.

In the Surveyor's opinion the working pressure of boiler to be reduced to 150 lb. pending a further examination of all boilers at the next boiler survey.
