Referring to your letter of the 26th instant respecting the steamer "HAMPHOLM" we beg to inform you that we are now in receipt of a letter from the owner's consulting engineer, stating that this vessel is expected to arrive at Hamburg medio July next, The owner requests to have the renewal of the stern frame postponed for about 6 months' time, and he states that when the vessel has been discharged at Hamburg, there will be an opportunity for the Society's Surveyor to examine the temporary repair of the stern frame etc.

The consulting engineer states, that it is very important for the owner to have the renewal of the stern frame postponed and we shall be glad to be informed whether the owner's request may be agreed to, provided the Surveyor finds the temporary repair in order.
