H Dear Sirs,

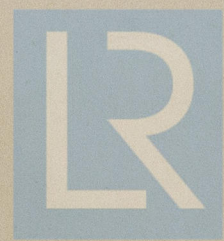
I have to acquaint you that a Report was received last month of a survey held by the Society's Surveyors at Newport Mon. on the Steamer "MONCOUSU", in which it was stated that thirty fathoms of chain cable require to be supplied to bring the vessel's equipment up to the reduced war emergency standard.

In the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Managers, Messrs. George Gibson & Co., Ltd., what arrangements are proposed to be made for this matter to receive attention.

I should add that the Boiler Survey has been carried out and a record of "B.S. 3,41" assigned, subject to four stoppered tubes ⁱⁿ of the donkey boiler being renewed at the first opportunity.
