Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letters of the 6th and 18th instant, respecting the cases of the Steamers "NEW TEXAS" and "NEW TORONTO" respectively (your first entry reports Nos. 8218 and 8224 respectively) I have to inform you that the proportion of the fees which will be chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey of these vessels during construction up to the time of transfer to private ownership, will be 20% between the fees as a Standard Vessel and the ordinary classification fees for the survey of the Hull in each case, and 37.5% for the survey of the machinery, viz:-
