Sir,

In reply to your note in the Classing Letter of 11th inst. regarding the Electric Light wiring of S.S. "NEW BRUNSWICK" the size of the cables given in my Report is correct.

But it has to be pointed out that the nomenclature of the cables varies. Some firms (Harland & Wolff among them), always designate the cables from the main switch board to the subcircuits as the "main cables".

Others assume the dynamo mains to the main switch board to be the "main cables", and they are so reported; although I have generally found in practice that the men and officials usually adopt the former method of designating them.

In the present instance the cables from the dynamo to the main Switch board are in excess of our Rules being 19/14 S.W.G.

Trusting this will make the matter clear.
