"ANGLE ATTACHING NEW BRACKETS TO TANK TOP MAY BE FIVE BY
"FIVE BY POINT SIX FIVE STOP ARM OF BRACKET ON FRAME SHOULD
"BE DOUBLE RIVETED BUT NUMBER OF RIVETS IN EACH ARM MAY
"BE SIXTEEN".
