Nature of Survey

*Examination for G.L.*

This vessel was built in 1912 and classed with Germanischer Lloyds.

The Bombay Surveyor now reports the vessel has been placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated.

One plate in "A", "B", "C" & "D" strakes found badly indented.

Temporary repairs are stated to have been carried out at Newcastle in December 1915, *now examined found efficient*

The holds, 'tween decks, fore & after peaks, decks, Engine & Boiler spaces & casings, bunkers, hatches, & hatch coamings, examined & found satisfactory.

The bunkers require scaling.

The steering gear, windlass & watertight doors examined and found in order.

It is submitted the notation of "G.L." Bom, 8. 17, be assigned.
