

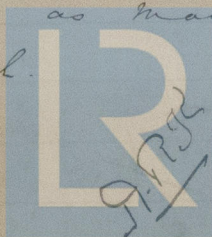
Steel's Diyatalawa or "Rappenfels".
No 483 in the Register Book, 5883 tons Gross, built
at Vegesack in 1912, and classed with the Germanischer
Lloyd -

It is submitted the writer has
informed that with a view to classification with the
Society it will be necessary for plans (if available),
showing the scantlings & arrangements adopted in
the construction of the hull, machinery & boilers to
be submitted for the consideration of the Committee,
or for the vessel to be examined & the scantlings
& arrangements ascertained & reported upon.

The requirements of the rules for the Special
Survey No 2 and Section 48 of the rules for
vessels not built under survey will also
require to be complied with.

The fee charged for classification should
be say 100 guineas for hull & machinery.

If it is decided to carry out the
Survey for classification the Bombay Surveyor should
be fully advised & informed that in the 1914
Germanischer Lloyd Register the boiler pressures
were respectively recorded as main 192 & donkey
boiler 121 lbs per square inch.
