

S.S. "NIGARISTAN" ex "DIYATALAWA".

This ex-German vessel is undergoing survey at Falmouth for classification with this Society.

The case was considered on the 19th May, but, in the absence of a profile plan, definite recommendations in regard to the class were not made.

A plan of profile has since been received, and approval was given on the 8th instant to the omission of a Watertight Bulkhead.

A plan of Midship Section, traced and translated from a German print, has been forwarded. The scantlings have been examined and it is submitted that upon receipt of a favourable report regarding the survey for classification, the vessel will be eligible to be recommended for the class 100A-.

With regard to the survey, the Surveyors' attention might be directed to the 3rd and 4th clauses in the Secretary's letter of the 19th ultimo. The particulars requested relating to the equipment should be forwarded at the earliest possible moment, certificates of test of anchors and cables being enclosed, if obtainable.
