

S.S. "NIGARISTAN"

ex S.S. "DIYATALAWA", No. 13959 in R.B.

Owners:- Messrs. F. C. Strick & Co.

This ex-German vessel is at present undergoing survey for classification at Falmouth.

She is of a length to require by Rule seven Watertight Bulkheads. From a general arrangement plan handed in today by Mr. Walker, the Owners' representative, it is seen that there are only six watertight bulkheads, the intermediate bulkhead usually placed in the forehold being omitted.

Suitable structural compensation for the omission of the bulkhead in question is afforded by an increased size in the framing, and it is submitted that provided the following notation be made in the Register Book, viz,-

"BH in forward hold dispensed with: 6 BH only",
the existing disposition of bulkheads might be approved.

Mr. Walker, it might be observed, stated that the Owners desired that not more than 6 Watertight bulkheads should be fitted.
