Précis of particulars of Casualty This vessel was torpedoed and beached at Llanza on the 18th March, 1938. She was refloated and towed into Marseilles where she came under the inspection of the Society's Surveyors.
In the circumstances action was deferred pending the receipt of the Surveyors' report on the case.
The Surveyors now report they have made a general examination and in their opinion the vessel is unfit for service in her present condition.
They also state that it is the intention of the French Government to buy her and convert her into a pontoon and it is understood that the negotiations respecting the sale are somewhat advanced.
