First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the London Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is proceeding to Great Yarmouth to be fitted with her machinery at that port, and to complete the survey for classification the top of the E&B casings requires to be riveted up after the engines and boiler are in place. They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention and on completion of the work to their satisfaction to report upon the same on form No. 8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.

The Hull Surveyors should be requested to state the breaking tests of the 2" and 2½" steel wire hawsers.
