I have to inform you that it appears from a first entry report on the new steamer "ESPERANTO", received from the Society's Surveyors at Hull, that this vessel is proceeding to Great Yarmouth where her machinery will be fitted on board, and that to complete the survey for classification the top of the engine and boiler casings requires to be riveted up after the engines and boilers are in place.
