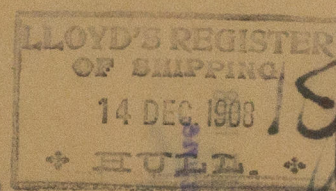
attend at the Humber Brass and Copper Works Co's works on the

copper Main Steam Pipe with flanges brazed on, intended for
Messrs Crabtree & Co's No.386 Engines.

The pipe which is of three inch bore, by eight gauge was
tested by hydraulic pressure to three hundred pounds per square
inch, and a sample piece cut from the pipe was flattened till
sides met. Both tests were satisfactory.

The Pipe has been marked JB on flanges, and is being sent
to Great Yarmouth.
