The class is subject to indented stem plating and framing being dealt with as necessary at the next dry docking and to the equipment of ropes being placed in order at the first opportunity.

The PORT NATAL Acting Surveyor reports (10.42) the vessel examined afloat on account of damage during heavy weather, and repairs effected to ventilators, and lifeboats etc.
