We are in receipt of your letter of yesterday's date with reference to Cardiff Report No. 42,736 on Steamer "MAID OF SPARTA" ex "MINNA HORN", and note contents. The Owners' representative (Captain Leondopoulos) has been advised accordingly, and will arrange for additional chain cable to be supplied to meet the rule requirements.

In place of tank margin gusset plates, a continuous strake of plating is fitted connecting margin plate to reverse angles on frame brackets, as shown on midship section.

The close ceiling in holds is fitted only under hatches and over limber spaces.
