

Dear Sirs,

E. With reference to Mr. Barclay's letter of the 25th ultimo submitting for the consideration of the Committee a plan of the boilers of the S.S. "MINNA HORN" built in 1913 under the supervision of the Surveyors to the Germanischer Lloyd and now at your Port under survey with a view to classification with this Society, I have to acquaint you that, provided the boilers be opened out, examined, and be found in good order and safe working condition; their scantlings be in accordance with the plan, and the furnaces be found to shew no sign of strain, they will be accepted, in this instance, for the original working pressure of 160 lbs per square inch.

At the same time I have to request that you will furnish the following particulars, viz:- diameter of cylinders, length of stroke, sizes of shafting, diameter of propeller and whether the screw shaft is fitted with a continuous liner or otherwise.

A plan of the pumping arrangements should be forwarded if obtainable.
