Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your telegram of yesterday's date respecting the ex-German Steamer "MINNA HORN", viz:-

"EXGERMAN STEAMER MINNA HORN NEW OWNERS STATE  
"CLASSIFICATION NOW APPLIED FOR PLEASE WIRE WHETHER  
"IN ORDER TO PROCEED WITH SURVEY FOR CLASS AND  
"FREEBOARD".

With regard to this case, I enclose herewith a copy of a letter dated 22nd instant which has been received from Messrs. D. & T. G. Adams on this subject, and have to inform you, in confirmation of my telephone conversation this morning, that the Ministry of Shipping state that the sale of this vessel has not been definitely completed, as the bottom repairs, which are being done under your supervision, are not finished and are awaiting the arrival of a new stern frame. The Ministry of Shipping add that the prospective Buyers have applied to them for permission to commence work on the engines and boilers; but that permission has been refused by the Ministry, although they have been allowed to put in hand some repairs to six plates above the water line.
