I duly received your letter of the 8th instant, with reference to the survey at present being held at your port on the ex-German Steamer "MINNA HORN", and in reply to your enquiry, I have to state that as the set to starboard of the stern frame is in your opinion original, and does not interfere with the working of the rudder, the pintles of which appear to be in line, it is considered that the stern frame may be accepted for classification, provided you are satisfied as to the soundness of the stern frame and rudder, and the latter is in good working condition.


