shaft and bearings. Main Engine compressors, cylinders, pistons,
rods, valves, crank shaft and bearings. Forward and centre dynamo
engines complete. Steam dynamo engine complete. Kromhout dynamo
engine complete. Steam driven air compressor (compressor only). Condenser
tested. Boiler feed pumps. Stand-by Lubricating oil pump. Fuel oil
transfer pumps. Condensate pump. Starboard inboard and outboard
starting air reservoirs. Forward Main engine blast bottle. Donkey
boilers examined and safety valves adjusted under steam.
Main Engine compressors. Top and bottom ends and pins.
