With reference to previous correspondence respecting the above tanker we beg to advise you that on and since the 14th ultimo we have been in close touch with Mr. James Anderson, the Deputy Manager of the Socony Vacuum Company at Athens. On the 20th he informed us that owing to war conditions in the Eastern Mediterranean their Istanbul Office had been unable, up to then, to arrange for the vessel to come to Piraeus. (I advised you of this in my general letter of the 25th June). On the 1st inst. we were advised that one month's extension had been obtained and that she was ~~laid~~ up but that they were still trying to load her for this port. Today Mr. Anderson informs us he has been advised from Istanbul that arrangements for a further extension have been made between the London representatives of the Company and Lloyd's Register at London and thus the matter rests.
