# Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

This is to Certify that

JOHN RUNDLE

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

Messrs Watson & Youell, Ltd., Lloyd's Agents, and with the consent of the Master attend on board the steel screw "PEGASUS", 3597 tons gross of Hong-Kong, whilst the vessel was lying afloat at Constantza on the 12th January 1940 for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of the damage stated to have been sustained when the steel screw "CHRYSSOROI", 379 tons gross of Piraeus, whilst proceeding alongside the oil basin at Constantza on the 12th January 1940, came into collision with the "PEGASUS" which, at the time, was lying alongside the quay.

FOUND

No. 1 shell plate in the third strake below sheer on the starboard side found to have a small but deep indent with a fracture about two and a half inches long. The web frame in way slightly buckled.

RECOMMENDED

Indent to be faired in place and fracture to be electrically welded. The web frame to be faired in place.

As a temporary repair to enable the vessel to proceed on her voyage, two cement boxes have been fitted in the fore peak, one on each side of the web frame, and the fracture has also been plugged with wood wedges.

All removals necessary to carry out the foregoing recommendations to be afterwards replaced and made good with part new material if necessary. The vessel to be restored as far as practicable to the same good and efficient condition as before the alleged damage occurred.
