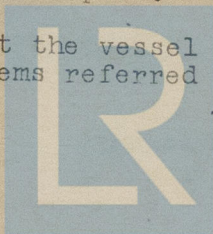

The Surveyor states that a hydrostatic pressure one and a half times the working pressure was applied in the testing of the boilers and steam pipes. The safety valves of the water tube boilers were adjusted to 200 lbs. pressure and the donkey boiler valves were adjusted to 70 lbs. pressure. The Surveyor regrets omitting this information from his report.

He has been informed that the vessel is expected here in about a month's time when the items referred to will receive attention.
