I am returning to your address to-day, under separate cover, one copy of each of the plans, forwarded with Mr. Priest's letter of the 6th instant, of midship section, profile and decks of the Single Screw Oil Tanker, Yard No. 774, proposed to be built by Messrs. Howaldtswerke A.G., Kiel, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" with the notations "Longitudinal Framing" "Bracketless System".


The steel to be used in the construction of the vessel should be made by the Open Hearth process at Works recognised by the Committee and be tested in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.
