This Quadrant has been made of S.M. Steel and electrically welded with approved electrodes as per Section 4. Clause 1-7. of the Society's Rules in accordance with the approved plan dated 21.9.36.

The Quadrant has been examined during construction and in a finished condition and was found to be so far as could be seen, sound and free from defects. The workmanship is of good quality. The plate material and the forgings have been made at works recognized by the Committee and tested by the Society's Surveyors as required by the Rules.
