With reference to your letters of the 29th June and 29th July respecting the sea water degassing apparatus and Hammemann regulator proposed by Messrs. Atlas Werke for Messrs. Howaldtswerke's Yard No.756, I have to acquaint you that the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 29th June, will be approved for a working pressure of 28 lb. per sq. inch, provided the degassing apparatus and the regulator be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

With reference to the T piece of fabricated welded construction, shown on the plan of evaporator approved in my letter of the 5th July last, this T piece could be accepted in this instance, provided you are satisfied with the Firm's welding technique, the T piece be examined and found sound and free from defects and be subjected to a hydraulic test of 4 times the working pressure with satisfactory results.
