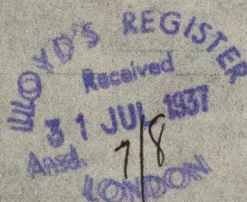

Referring to your letter of the 5th instant regarding plans of distiller condenser, evaporator, Hannemann regulator and degasser, proposed by Messrs. Atlas-Werke A.G., Bremen, for Messrs. Howaldtswerke A.G., Kiel, Yard No. 756, I beg to inform you with regard to the T piece that it is stated by the Manufacturers that a similar T piece was approved by your letter of the 9th January, 1936, for Messrs. Bremer Vulkan's Yard No. 718. It is submitted by Messrs. Atlas-Werke that the T piece be approved also in this instance, as it has already been fabricated.

With regard to your enquiry respecting the plans of Hannemann regulator and degasser, I beg to inform you that it is stated by the Manufacturers that the working pressures of these parts is the same as that of the Evaporator.
