I duly received your letter of the 29th ultimo, with plans advised therein of distiller condenser, evaporator, Hannemann regulator and degasser, proposed by Messrs. Atlas-Werke A.G., Bremen, for Howaldtswerke A.G., Kiel, Yard No. 758, and I have to inform you that the plan of distiller condenser will be approved for a working pressure of 3.1 Kgs per sq. cm., provided the condenser be constructed as shown on the plan and to your satisfaction.

Further, the plan of evaporator will be approved for working pressures of 28 lb. per sq. inch and 145 lb. per sq. inch on the vapour and heating steam sides respectively, provided the evaporator be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

With regard to the T piece, shown on the plan, of fabricated welded construction, for the steam inlet, I have to point out that before approval can be given to the manufacture of T pieces of this type subjected to steam pressure, it will be necessary for the Firm to carry out a comprehensive series of tests, particulars of which may be obtained on application to this Office, in order to demonstrate

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their ability to make these T pieces satisfactorily.

In connection with the plans of Hannemann regulator and degasser, I shall be glad if you will state for what working pressures approval of these plans is desired.
