Dear Sir,

E. I duly received your letter of the 22nd instant forwarding copies of the Germanischer Lloyd Certificate in respect of the plain and stay tubes to be fitted in the three main boilers of Messrs. Howaldtswerke's Yard No.756.

It is noted that these boiler tubes are made of open hearth steel, but have been tested by the Germanischer Lloyd instead of by the Society's Surveyors, and in reply I have to say that, in the circumstances, the tubes will be accepted provided the Surveyors are able to satisfy themselves that the steel has been made by a Firm whose name appears in the Society's Approved List and that the results of tests carried out in the presence of the Surveyors on 6 plain and 2 stay tubes, taken at random from the batch of tubes, are found to be satisfactory.

The original G.L. Certificate is returned herewith.




