

Dear Sir,

Reverting to your letter of the 4th ult. regarding the arrangement of lighting in the pump rooms of Messrs. Howaldtswerke Yard No.756, I have to advise you that duplicate copies of an amended plan are being submitted today under separate cover for the approval of the Committee.

Messrs. Howaldtswerke have dealt with Points 1 and 2, as given in your letter of the 4th March, and the revised proposals are shown on the amended plan and will otherwise be in accordance with what has been required in your letter. The Builders point out that Switches are not being fitted in the fittings for lighting. The plug which is being provided in the fitting marked EF will only be used when there is no current in the system and on such occasions this plug will only be used when the tube EF has been opened. We request you to approve the Glycerine trap shown on the plan, as this is necessary to drain off moisture resulting from condensation and sweating. The Builders state that they do not agree with the opinion expressed in the London letter to the effect that the maintenance of this arrangement is not dependable. The Builders are of the opinion that the lighting fittings in tankers and in particular in these tankers are given very careful supervision in services. The Builders, therefore,
