A further letter has been received from the Leith Surveyors enclosing one from the Builders regarding the date of build to be entered in the Register Book for this vessel. The Builders state that it has always been customary in their experience to have the final survey during the course of the trial trip, with the Society's Surveyor present, and when asked for their views on this point some time ago by the Owners they stated that the date would, as usual, be that of the final report of the Surveyor made with reference to his survey during the final official trial trip, and that they were unaware of any rule to the contrary.

The Surveyors re-submit the question for the Committee's further consideration.

As the Leith Surveyors stated in their letter of the 12th instant that the main and auxiliary engines were found satisfactory for classification on the results of the dock trials, it is not seen why it should be necessary to wait for the official trials, and it is therefore submitted that the Committee's decision already made regarding the date of build should be adhered to.
