Mr. Alexander, of Messrs. Capper Alexander & Co., the  
owners of this vessel, called here about a week ago in reference  
to this vessel and stated that they were surprised to receive  
Classification Certificates from the Builders.


He explained that the official trials of the vessel  
had not taken place and that the Builders' contract with them  
could not be completed until the full power trials at sea had  
been carried out, and until this was done they did not intend  
to take delivery of the vessel.

I mentioned that I concluded from this that he  
required a later date to be recorded on the Classification  
Certificates as the date of completion and he concurred.

On inquiring what steps he should take in the matter  
I informed him that the best course for him to follow was to  
return the Certificates to the Builders explaining his attitude  
and I added that no doubt the matter would be taken up with  
the Society's Surveyors at Leith who would submit the question  
to this Office for consideration in due course.

The matter was mentioned to the Chairman of the  
Classification Committee who informed me that Mr. Alexander  
had also mentioned the point to him and that he had advised  
me also to the above effect.

In the meantime the Chairman of Classification  
considered that the posting of the Date of Build should be  
deferred pending the receipt of a letter on the subject.
