REMMAREN. — Stockholm, Oct. 22. — Swedish motor vessel Remmaren, of Gothenburg, has been lost in the North Atlantic, it was disclosed to-day. All the crew were picked up by two other Swedish vessels. No details of how the Remmaren was sunk were given. — Reuter.

REMMAREN. — Stockholm, Oct. 22. — According to newspaper reports from Trelleborg reaching Stockholm the Swedish motor vessel Remmaren has been sunk off the Norwegian coast while on her way to Gothenburg. — British United Press. (See issue of Oct. 23.)

LL 24/10

Stockholm, Oct. 22. — It was reported this evening that the Swedish motor vessel Remmaren sank after striking a mine. She was on her way to Gothenburg from Buenos Aires with a cargo of linseed cake, hides and skins. — Reuter.

London, Oct. 22. — According to a Vichy report the motor vessel Remmaren carried a crew of 37. She was due to arrive at Gothenburg to-day. — Reuter.
