

Dear Sir,

Reverting to your letter dated 29th ultimo returning a plan of Masts and Derricks approved for Messrs. Lindholmens Yard No.964 I beg to acquaint you that we have been informed by the builders that an arrangement of shrouds and stays is specially desired by the Owners such that the derricks can swing to an angle of about 90° to the centre line without having to disturb the rigging.

The arrangements indicated on the plan were therefore designed to meet the Owners wishes and it is pointed out that in order to provide an equivalent to the Society's requirements the single shroud proposed each side is of increased size, and, in addition to the rigging indicated in Table 48, a back stay and a top mast fore stay are fitted to each mast.

In these circumstances the builders proposals are submitted for favourable consideration provided the shrouds to the main mast be increased to $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

to the main mast be increased to 1 1/2 ft. above the
level of the water in the centre of the mast
in order to provide an adequate margin of safety
in the event of a heavy sea. The proposed
arrangement is shown in the sketch attached
and will be found to be a simple and effective
method of increasing the height of the mast
without the necessity of increasing the
weight of the mast or the strength of the
structure. It is suggested that the
arrangement be adopted for the main mast
of the ship.

The arrangements indicated on the plan were therefore
approved by the Committee and the necessary
arrangements have been made for the
main mast of the ship. It is suggested
that the same arrangement be adopted
for the other masts of the ship.
