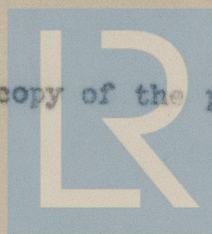

I duly received your letter of the 21st instant regarding the masts to be constructed by Messrs. Deutsche Rohrenwerke A.G. to the order of Messrs. A/B Lindholmens-Varv, Gothenburg, and intended for their Yard No. 964, and I now return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter, of masts and derricks giving particulars of supports and rigging etc., and have to state that the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended will be approved, provided they be carried out to the Surveyors' satisfaction.

The Rules do not provide scantlings for derrick posts, and the scantlings of masts and rigging as detailed in the Rules are considered suitable for the support of an average equipment of derricks of normal outreach. I shall therefore be glad if you will inform the Builders that the plan has been dealt with on this basis, and that the responsibility for the design of these members suitable for the special conditions proposed must rest between the Owners and the Builders.
