In reply to your letter dated 22nd ultimo regarding the General Pumping Arrangement of Messrs. A.-B. Lindholmen Varv's Yard No.964, I beg to acquaint you that the Builders propose to fit one 3" air pipe to No.7 double bottom tank instead of the two separate 2½" air pipes referred to in the second ~~part~~ ^{paragraph} of your letter.

Two of the three 2½" bilge suction at the after end of the machinery space are led to the wells under the main engine. The 3rd bilge suction is led to the tank top between the motors.

The Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances are to be constructed under Special Survey.
