In reply to your query in the classing letter of the 27th instant regarding the First Entry Report No. 26434 on the steamer "ROSE CASTLE" I beg to state that the size of the upper deck stringer angle is $7 \times 7 \times .80$ the riveting of the edges of L & M strakes is $1\frac{1}{8}$ " with breadth of lap $6\frac{3}{4}$ and spacing $4\frac{1}{2}$ " the thickness of the sheerstrake at ends of bridge is 1.30 and I regret that these inaccuracies should have occurred.
