Dear Sir,

I have received from the Society's Surveyor at Marseilles, copy of an order, which please find enclosed, herewith, placed by a Firm of that port to Messrs Bouchenot & Co, Vaux-sur-Blaise (Haute Marne) for cast-iron pieces intended for the S/S "ROSE SCHIAFFINO".-

The place, geographically, appears to be nearer Metz than Paris, but, from the latter, means of communications are more direct : Distance 160 miles about.-

I should be obliged if you would kindly inform me whether, Mr. Poincet should be instructed to carry out this inspection, and, if so, whether such an Inspection should be confined to a surface examination; unless, in view of the distance between the Works and the place of residence of the Society's Surveyors, and on the other hand, in view of the nature of the material, the Inspection can be carried out by the Surveyors at Marseilles on their arrival at the repairers' Works at that port.-
