A. I beg to inform you that I am advised by the Ministry of Shipping that the survey fees chargeable on vessels which were originally commenced as Standard vessels and subsequently taken over by Lord Inchcape are, in accordance with the terms of the agreement with Lord Inchcape, payable by the Builders.
