Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 22nd instant respecting the fees chargeable for the survey during construction of the engines and boilers made by Messrs. Richardsons, Westgarth & Co. Ltd., (their No. 2603), for the S.S. "PAIGNON" built by Messrs. The Blyth Shipbuilding Co. Ltd., I have to inform you that an account for the ordinary rule first entry and classification fees should be rendered to the Builders in this case, viz:-

First Entry Fee.....	£ 3. 0. 0.
Survey fee.....	38. 8. 0.

I note what you say with regard to the percentage of work which was completed on the engines and boilers up to the date of transfer to private ownership, and on receipt of the completed First Entry Reports from Newcastle you will be advised as to what additional fee will be chargeable to the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding.

The fees as stated above have been entered on your First Entry Report which has been forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle.
