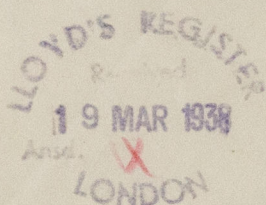

In reply to your letter of the 17th instant regarding the diameter of the thrust shafts made for Messrs. Richardsons Westgarth & Co., Ltd., Contract No. 2690 (T.S.S. "ROSALIA"), we have to inform you that owing to a machining error on one shaft, making the diameter 208.5 m/m, at the Owners' request the other shaft was reduced to make both shafts alike before being sent to Messrs. Michell for assembly in the thrust blocks. The rule size for these shafts is 200 m/m.
