Sir,

I enclose herewith a letter received from Messrs Harland & Wolff, having reference to the 7" steel wire hawser supplied to their St. No 390 "Rotterdam" ^{in lieu of steam chain}, and proposing to substitute two 5" ropes each 120 fathoms in length in lieu thereof.

It is submitted that provided the two 5" steel wire ropes be each 150 fathoms in length the Builders proposal merits approval.

The equipment of hawsers & warps proposed for this vessel was submitted in Mr. Milton's letter of the 3rd December last.
