With reference to our letter of the 8th instant, relative to the proposal to lengthen the steamers "SEROOOSKERK" and "ZUIDERKERK", I beg to state that the Owners have decided to have the length increased by about 5 Metres,

In connexion therewith we shall be pleased to hear whether the present equipment may be considered sufficient for the lengthened ship.

The Owners further expressed their desire to retain the existing rudders, although the speed of the vessels will be increased by 1 knot.

The vessels were originally fitted with an ordinary single plate rudder which was converted into a rudder of the Oertz type in 1931.

Your early reply will be much appreciated.
