Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the fee for the survey during construction of the rotors being made by the British Thomson-Houston Co. Ltd. for the Steamers "SEROOSKIRK" and "ZUIDERKERK".

With regard thereto I have to confirm the arrangement subsequently agreed over the telephone with Mr. Pringle that the inclusive fee of £21 arranged for this work should be divided equally between the London and Sheffield accounts. Your account will accordingly be credited with £10. 10. 0 on payment of the inclusive fee.

It is noted that your travelling expenses amount to £1. 4. 0, but in this connexion I may say that the figure agreed upon with the Makers was inclusive of expenses.
