E. I am favoured with your letter of the 12th instant from which it is noted that you have received an order from the Owners of the Steamers "SEROOSKERK" and "ZUIDERKERK" for new HP and LP rotors complete with bucket wheels and blading for both vessels in order to make the turbines suitable for 5,000 HP at a turbine speed of 4,000 rpm, and that although you have not been asked to build the rotors to any particular survey you consider it advisable to do so under the Society's inspection.
