Dear Sir,

In reply to your classing letter of the 10th. instant respecting our report No. 12167 on the S.S. "GEMMA" I beg to inform you that the Collision Bulkhead extends to the Shelterdeck as concluded. In addition to the Collision Bulkhead the holdbulkheads Nos. 36 and 125 extend also to the Shelterdeck while the remaining bulkheads Nos. 8, 65, 87 and 103 extend to the Upperdeck with the exception of the deep tank bulkhead No. 54 which extends to the 2nd deck only. The inner surface of the bottom plating clear of the oil tanks is protected by cement.
