We are in receipt of your favour of the 6th inst., for which we thank you and note the usual procedure is for classification certificates to be transmitted to the Builders and Engine Makers, which in the case of the above steamer will be quite in order as eventually these documents will come into our possession.

However, when you do forward certificates is it possible for you to send them in duplicate in order that a copy may be retained on board steamer. As explained in our last letter, when boats arrive at a Portuguese port, to which the above steamer is fixed to trade, the Authorities demand proof that steamer was in a seaworthy condition on leaving loading port and as such evidence they accept the classification certificate.


