Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st instant from which it is noted that you intend to increase the height of the tank side brackets to $5\frac{1}{2}$ " above the base in the above vessel. On account of this increased height, the frames may be as under:-

$10 \times 3\frac{1}{2} \times .40$ B.A. (1924 standard) at $31\frac{1}{2}$ " spacing, - $.06"$ in boiler room and bunkers.

$5 \times 3\frac{1}{2} \times .47$ B.A. (1924 standard) at 27" spacing forward of $\frac{3}{5}$ th length, excluding panting.
