I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st instant from which it is noted that you intend to increase the height of the tank side brackets to 56½" above the base in the above vessel. On account of this increased height, the frames may be as under:-

10 x 3½ x .40 B.A. (1924 standard) at 31½" spacing, - .06" in boiler room and bunkers.

9 x 3½ x .47 B.A. (1924 standard) at 27" spacing forward of 3/5th length, excluding panting.
