Petroleum in Bulk.

The Sunderland Surveyors have submitted a letter from the Shipbuilders regarding the cable run through the centre castle space together with a plan showing the piping arrangement and the method of ventilating this space. They propose using lead covered, armoured and braided cables passing through this space to be clipped on metal trays.

The plan submitted has been examined and it is noted that a 12" diameter ventilator in conjunction with a ventilating grill is to be used for ventilating this space. It is considered that this arrangement will provide adequate ventilation ^{for the cables} and that under the circumstances the proposed arrangement to run these lead covered, armoured and braided main cables on metal trays might be approved as in previous cases.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Surveyors be informed accordingly and a telegram be sent to the Surveyors worded as follows:

"Proposed support of main cables in bridge space approved".
